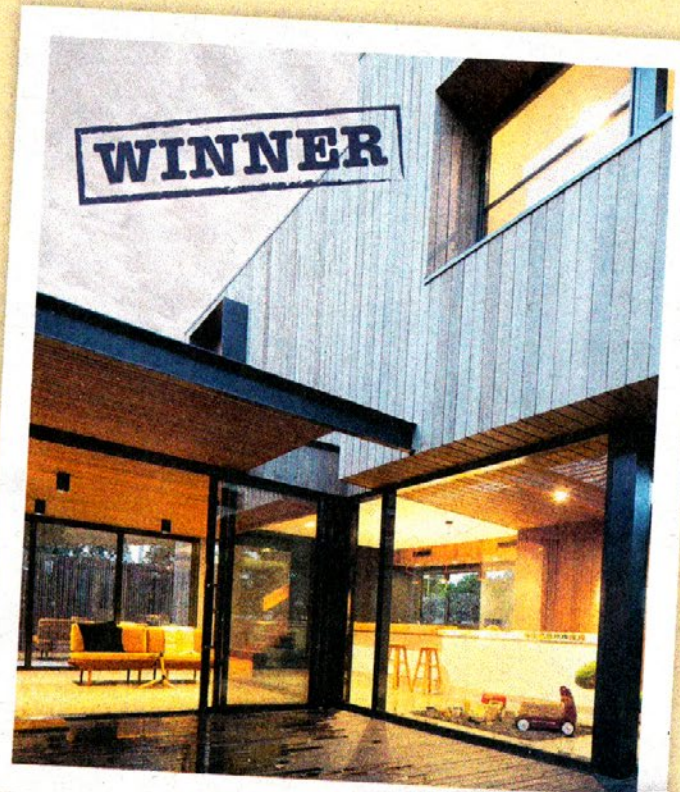
Works on this project required creating additional space on a limited site, without adversely affecting the surrounding context. The extra space consists of a new kitchen, informal living area, two bedrooms and an additional bathroom. The internal areas interact with the external environment either visually or physically via windows, courtyards and decks. To cater for the spatial requirements of additional bedrooms and living spaces, a double-storey solution was introduced, offering sufficient height to gain views of the surrounding areas.
